

Alberta's new Learner Pathways System supports student mobility and success



The new Learner Pathways System is:

Able to Access More Information: Get greater access to planning tools and information via the updated Transfer Alberta website, Search Tool and Mobile App.

Faster: Direct connections between post-secondary institutions' transfer decisions (in the Learner Pathways Catalog) and Transfer Alberta's Search applications provide instant access.

Up-to-Date: Get up-to-date course and program transfer agreements, information on high school transitions, academic upgrading courses, IB and AP courses for admissions.

More Flexible: Institutions and ACAT contacts can share course, program, and transfer data directly from their systems via mass upload (Data Collection and Reporting modules) or articulation of transfer agreements (Transfer Credit Evaluation System).

Able to Provide Custom Reporting: Institutions can manage their own data, create reports to view all data, and explore possibilities for reciprocal transfer or triangulation of agreements. The new ACAT website (available in 2018) will also provide targeted information for stakeholders.

Planning Learner Pathways

The updated Transfer Alberta Search Tool and Mobile App allow users to search as a high school student, post-secondary student, or education professional via keyword, course name, program name, or course number across multiple years and institutions.
