- <sup>7</sup> Because Portage College students are lacking in the number of contact hours that Lakeland College offers (48 hours versus 96 hours), Lakeland College will send applicants from Portage College an information package consisting of word processing, spreadsheets and databases, so students will understand the level of competency needed in computer applications.
