



Aurora College delivers programs at three campuses, 13 community learning centers and other community sites in the Northwest Territories.

Admission Requirements

Admission requirements for programs may vary from one program to another. Please check the detailed program sections of the College calendar for program-specific admission requirements. Applicants who do not have the academic requirements for entry may be admitted as mature students. A mature student must be 20 years of age or older, and have been out of school for at least one year. Mature applicants will be required to complete the Aurora College Placement Test.

Transfer Credits

Aurora College recognizes that learning experiences from other post-secondary educational institutions may be formally acknowledged by credit. The Office of the Registrar will coordinate all transfer credit requests and all decisions will be reviewed with the appropriate Program Head. Assessments will be done on an individual basis. All transfer credit requests must be submitted in writing along with official transcripts, and course detail information. In some cases, additional information may be required. Any student who has completed the equivalent of a College course at another institution with a completion grade of 60% or higher may apply for transfer credit. The maximum amount of credit which may be awarded from outside the College is 40% of the total credits necessary for graduation. Exceptions may be approved by the President.

The College has a variety of credit transfer arrangements with institutions and organizations. Additional information on transfer credits can be obtained from the Registrar.
