#### By Program

##### Business Administration Diploma

SAIT Graduates may be eligible for admission into SAIT's Bachelor of Applied Business Administration (Accounting major) upon completion of additional SAIT coursework prior to application. <sup>1</sup>

##### Early Learning and Childcare Certificate

Grande Prairie Graduates are eligible for admission directly into Year Two of GPRC's Early Learning and Child Care Diploma program.

##### Early Learning Child Care Certificate
